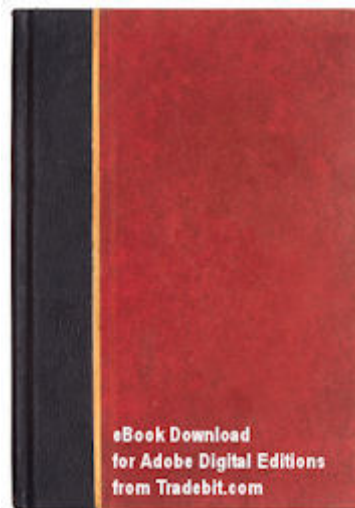


Abiotic Stress Responses In Plants
